## CDBG Program Overview (Information item)

### BACKGROUND

There are 3 main goals of CDBG;

1. To provide benefit to low and moderate income persons;
2. Prevent or eliminate or elimination of slums or blight conditions;
3. To meet a need of recent origin having a particular urgency.
  
4. The categories for which these funds may be used are in the areas of housing or neighborhood revitalization, commercial revitalization, and economic development and include a variety of activities including:

**Housing & Neighborhood Revitalization:** housing rehabilitation, demolition of dilapidated housing and relocation of residents, weatherization and energy-efficiency improvements, code enforcement, land assembly or site preparation for new construction, physical improvement activities such as water and sewer improvements, street improvements, drainage and neighborhood facilities. **Commercial Revitalization:** rehabilitation and demolition of dilapidated buildings, relocation of residents, physical improvement activities such as water and sewer improvements, street improvements, drainage and neighborhood facilities. **Economic Development:** infrastructure improvements, acquisition of real property loans to private-for-profit business, purchase of machinery and equipment or energy conservation.
