BACKGROUND

There are 3 main goals of CDBG;

1. To provide benefit to low and moderate income persons;
2. Prevent or eliminate or elimination of slums or blight conditions;
3. To meet a need of recent origin having a particular urgency.
4. The categories for which these funds may be used are in the areas of housing or neighborhood revitalization, commercial revitalization, and economic development and include a variety of activities including:

Housing & Neighborhood Revitalization: housing rehabilitation, demolition of dilapidated housing and relocation of residents, weatherization and energy-efficiency improvements, code enforcement, land assembly or site preparation for new construction, physical improvement activities such as water and sewer improvements, street improvements, drainage and neighborhood facilities. **Commercial Revitalization:** rehabilitation and demolition of dilapidated buildings, relocation of residents, physical improvement activities such as water and sewer improvements, street improvements, drainage and neighborhood facilities. **Economic Development:** infrastructure improvements, acquisition of real property loans to private-for-profit business, purchase of machinery and equipment or energy conservation.

RESOLUTION 2025-06

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILTON AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF THE FY2023/2024 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION APPLICATION.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Milton, Florida, is hereby making known its intention to apply to the State of Florida for Community Development Block Grant Neighborhood Revitalization assistance under the provision as set forth in Title 1 of Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as revised; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide sidewalk and water service improvements, including supporting infrastructure improvements the area bounded on the west by Stewart St., the east by Elmira, Willing, and Walton Streets, the north by Berryhill Street and the south by Walker and Filmore Streets. This area includes portions of Susan, Filmore, Santa Rosa, Combs, Pike, Escambia, Yew, Margaret, Elva, Ann, Alice and Jasmine Streets, with water infrastructure improvements in the general area containing Mary St. from Jasmine St. to Caroline St.; along Doctor Martin Luther King Dr. from W. Walker St. to Caroline St.; along Ann St. from Mary St. to Canal St.; Alice St.; along Jasmine Street from Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Dr to past Susan St.; along Walker St.; along Susan St. from Old Highway 90 to Jasmine St.; along Old Highway 90 from Canal St. to Susan St.; and Jackson St. The City Council does so with the understanding that the total estimated cost associated with the grant funded construction and administrative expenses applied for is \$2,267,245.19.

WHEREAS, the legislative body of the City of Milton, Florida, recognizes the Mayor as the appropriate City official authorized, in his/her/ capacity as Mayor to act on behalf of the City in such matters and further acknowledges that his/her signature shall be binding upon the City of Milton in such matters;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF MILTON:

- (1) That it approves the submission of the FFY 2023/2024 CDBG Neighborhood Revitalization application requesting \$2,267,245.19 for grant funded sidewalk and water infrastructure improvements; and
- (2) That the legislative body of the City of Milton, Florida agrees to pledge up to \$50,000 as match for the CDBG application.
- (3) That this legislative body of the City of Milton, Florida, hereby authorized the Mayor (or in his/her absence, the Mayor pro-tem) to act as the appropriate City official on behalf of the City of Milton, Florida, in dealings with the State of Florida and to sign any and all necessary application forms requesting FFY 23/34 CDBG assistance; as well as, submitting any additional information required

and signing any necessary contracts and/or other agreements between the State of Florida and the City of Milton, Florida that may result from this application.

- (4) That the City of Milton hereby authorizes the City Manager to sign any and all documents and reports for the proposed grant not expressly required to be signed by the chief elected official.
