BACKGROUND

Mr. Vernon Compton, Director of the Longleaf Alliance, is requesting authorization to harvest ground cover and other native plants from the sprayfields and wastewater plant sites in East Milton in advance of the clearing and grubbing activities. Staff has reviewed the request and agrees provided the City is granted a hold harmless agreement and provided proof of insurance from the organizations conducting the work.

SUMMARY

The Long Leaf Alliance is requesting authorization to harvest ground cover and native plants from the new sprayfields and wastewater treatment plant sites in advance of the clearing and grubbing of the properties.

RECOMMENDATION
