August 23, 2022, 5:30 p.m.

MINUTES

The City of Milton Community Improvement Board meeting was called to order at 5:30 P.M. on August 23rd, 2022. Present at the meeting were Chairwoman Cassandra Sharp, Board Members Ms. Brandi Bates, Mr. Cole Brunner, Mr. Sean McCool, and Mr. Kaiden Spurlock. City Staff present included Mr. Edward Spears, Mr. and Tim Milstead. City Councilmen Vernon Compton and Robert Leek were also present. These minutes are a synopsis of the actions taken at the meeting and are not intended as verbatim minutes.

- I. The meeting was called to order by Chairwoman Sharp at 5:30 p.m. She welcomed those in attendance and introduced City Staff. It was noted that a quorum was achieved.
- II. Chairwoman Sharp called for any additions, deletions, or changes to the meeting agenda. Ms. Bates made a motion to approve the meeting agenda as presented without objection. No objection was noted.
- III. Chairwoman Sharp called for any additions, deletions, or changes to the minutes of the previous meeting. Ms. Bates made a motion to approve the minutes as presented without objection. No objection was noted.
- IV. Chairwoman Sharp called on Mr. Milstead and Mr. Spears to present the revised CRA Plan. Mr. Milstead reviewed the data sections of the document and Mr. Spears the strategic plan aspects. Discussion followed. No changes were requested. Mr. Spurlock made a motion to recommend the draft plan update to the CRA for consideration. Mr. McCool seconded the motion. No discussion or public input was offered. The motion passed unanimously.
- V. No speakers came forward during the open forum.
- VI. Old Business – Mr. Milstead gave an update on the Food Truck Ordinance.
- VII. New Business – Mr. Spears advised the Board of a schedule conflict for the next meeting. As City Council will be hosting a budget workshop on September 27th, the meeting space and staff would be unavailable. The Board agreed to move the meeting to Thursday, September 29th, 2022 at 5:30 p.m.

Chairwoman Sharp advised the Board that the new proposed Neighborhood Commercial District Zoning information had been email to them and would be a future topic for discussion.

VIII. With no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 6:17 p.m.
